

STRIPMALL OFFICE WINDOWS IN THE NEW WHITE MATERIAL

BEFORE LOOK DURING CONSTRUCTION.
The office still heated up pretty good.
Not very pretty but cheap.



The white panels are installed using commercial grade Velcro.
The loop side is attached to the material and the hoop strip is mounted onto the metal frame.



The doors are framed with a white mutton bar that was mounted onto the glass.
This provides a gap between the material and the glass.
It also allows for a space between the material and the door handle.



Here is the view from the outside.
The white material offers a very clean bright look from the exterior, without any glare.
Daytime privacy is still maintained as with the original material.



The view from the inside is as clear as it could be.
The look is clean and crisp.
Privacy without giving up the benefits of natural daylight .
